Transfer of insurance to Zurich

Macquarie has made a strategic decision to transfer part of its life insurance business to Zurich Australia Limited (Zurich) and the Federal Court of Australia recently confirmed the transfer.

How will this affect you?

If you had insurance cover provided by Macquarie Life Limited through your SuperOptions account, your insurance cover was transferred to Zurich on 1 October 2016.

If you did not hold insurance cover through your SuperOptions account as at 30 September 2016, new insurance cover will no longer be available through your SuperOptions account.

If you wish to obtain insurance cover within another superannuation fund, we can facilitate a partial rollover to assist in meeting the associated insurance premium.
